Having considered Plaintiff Wi-LAN Inc.'s ("Wi-LAN") motion to compel Qualcomm Incorporated ("Qualcomm") to comply with a subpoena to produce documents, Qualcomm's opposition, the arguments of counsel, and for good cause shown:

The motion is GRANTED.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Qualcomm shall, on or before _____, 2010, produce:

- (i) each license agreement for Qualcomm's CDMA air interface technologies, including CDMA (also known as CDMA One), WCDMA and CDMA-2000;
- (ii) each license agreement for Qualcomm's OFDM air interface technologies, including for use in LTE and Wi-MAX wireless networks;
- (iii) each license agreement between Qualcomm and third-parties for technology included as part of Qualcomm's standard CDMA or OFDM licenses; and
- (iv) communications reflecting the negotiation of the terms of the license agreements listed in categories (i),(ii) and (iii).
